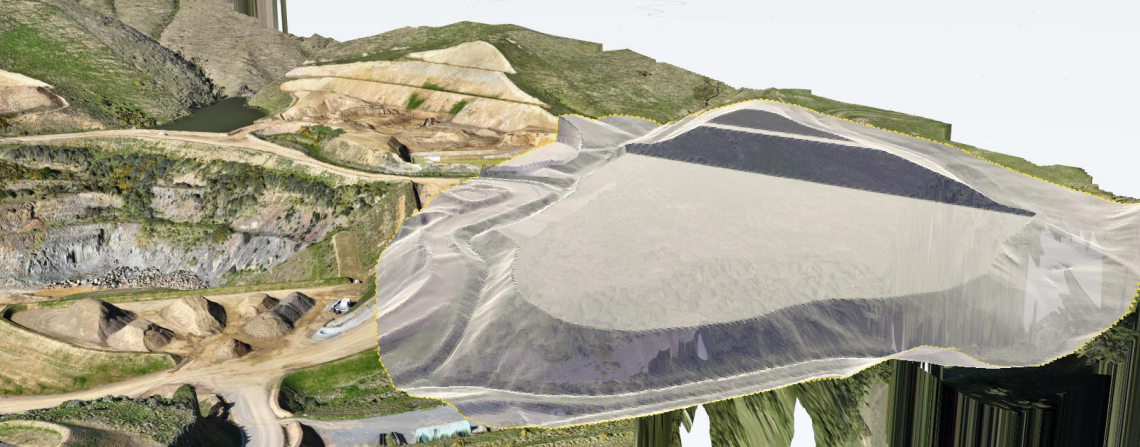


Activities since the last meeting!

- ✓ Additional Erosion and Sediment control installation at the Fill Site
- ✓ Stripping quarry Overburden to the Fill Site
- ✓ 40,500 plants ordered for Pig Gully
- ✓ Noise monitoring along notional boundary
- ✓ Lizard monitoring underway
- ✓ Undertaken 6 monthly Fill Site culvert inspection – No further recommendations

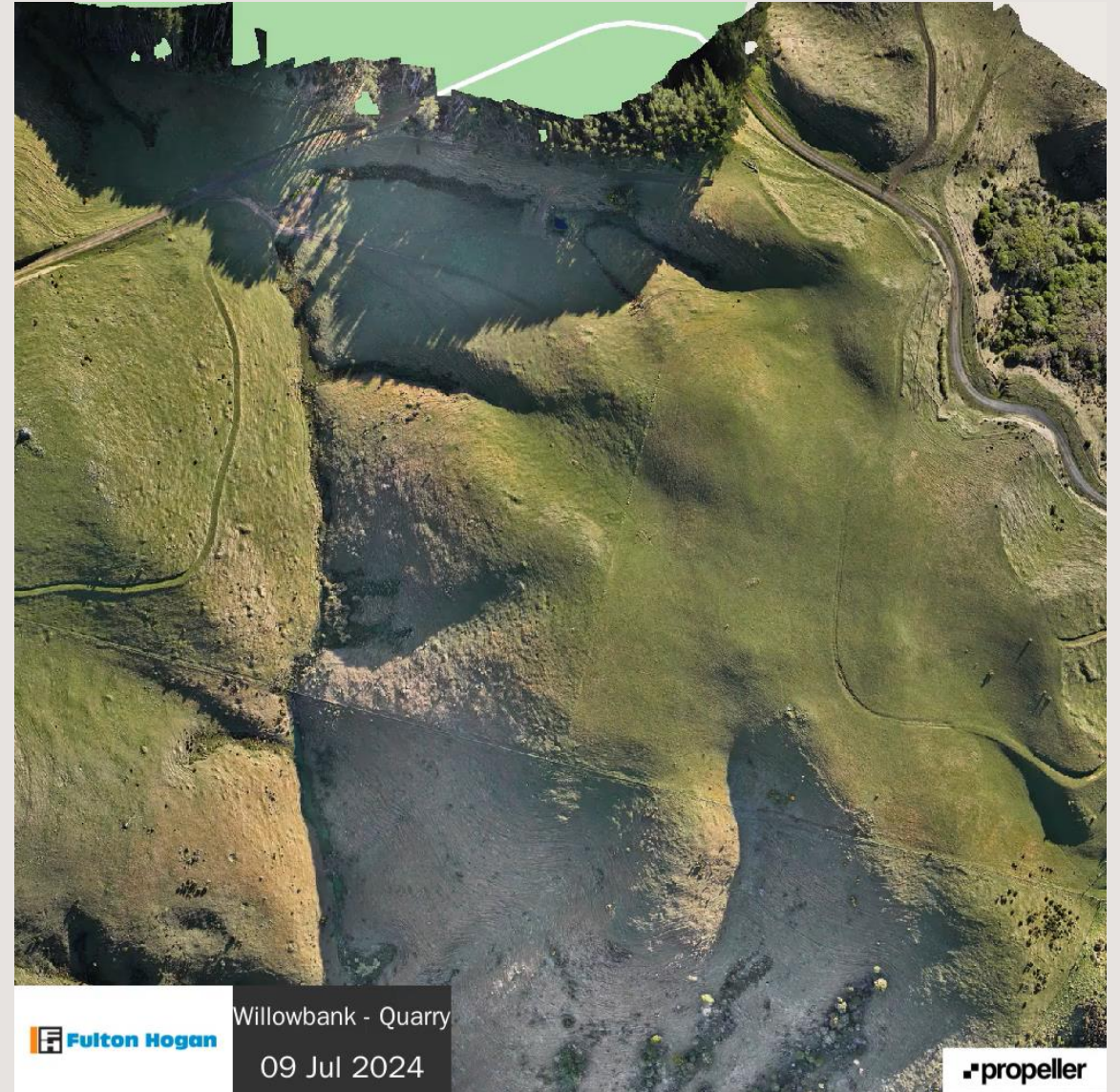


Stage 2 Overburden Removal

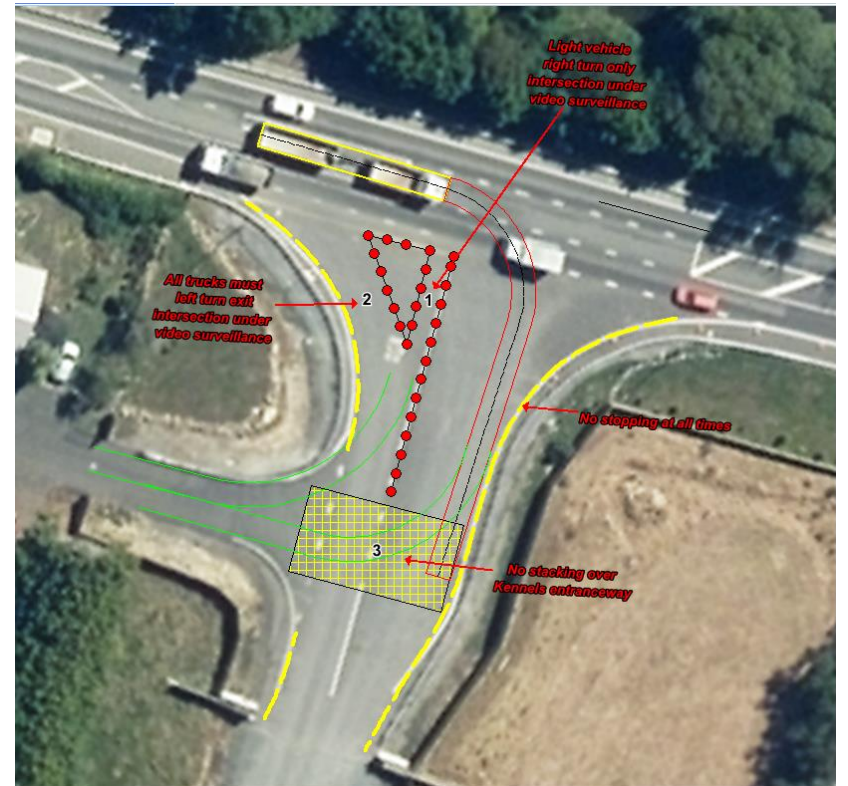

- ✓ Intersection upgrade outside the front gate
- ✓ Pothole repairs along quarry driveway
- ✓ Engineer and Ecologist review of the Stream Diversion design
