Friday 13<sup>th</sup> – Monday 16<sup>th</sup> Feb: Rainfall trigger limits reached (1hr, 6hr & 24hr).

Quarry Site: **Exceedance Levels not reached**

Fill Site: **NTU trigger exceeded by 0.15NTU (1.9%)**
