 - Overburden extraction and placement from Stage 2 and Stage 3 extraction areas to Quarry Fill Site (+/- 250k m3
 - Stripping of grass and enclosure preparations of Pig Gully Biodiversity and Off Set area including Lizard relocation sites
 - Planting within Pig Gully
 - Stream diversion works (Stage 1 & 2)

No noise and vibration monitoring undertaken with respects to blasting during this reporting period due to no blasting required.

Noise monitoring was undertaken by Marshall Day Acoustics using both handheld devices and fixed monitors.
Handheld devices concluded that the noise levels reached at the property concerned had louder background noise then that of the quarry. Noise recorded at the property recorded 48 and 50dB Laeq.

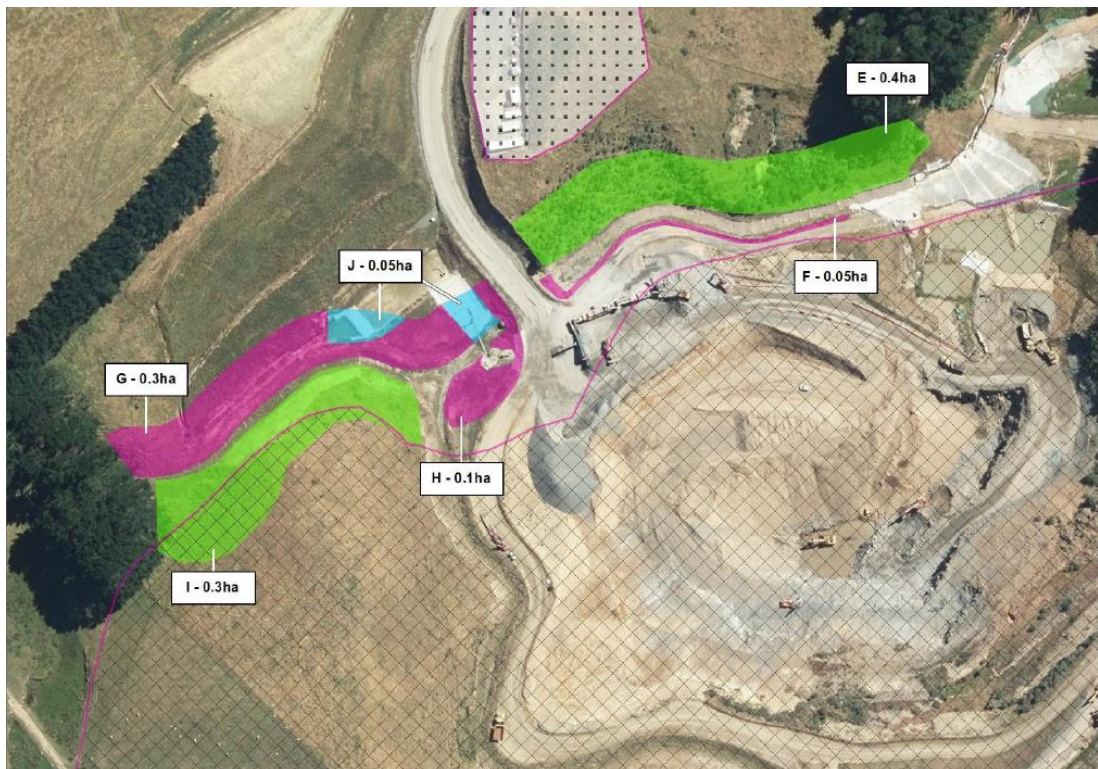
